GEORGETOWN ROAD IN CARNEYS POINT TOWNSHIP TO CLOSE FOR NEW WATER AND SEWER MAINS

(SALEM, NJ)—Freeholder Deputy Director Bruce Bobbitt, Chair of the County Public Works Committee, today announced that Georgetown Road, in Carneys Point Township will be closed the week of December 10th for the purpose of installing new water mains and new sanitary sewer lines.

"The work will be in the area west of South Golfwood Avenue to State Highway 130," said Deputy Director Bobbitt. "As always the road will be open to local traffic and emergency vehicles at all times during the construction. Others are encouraged to follow the posted detour route."

The work is being done by R.E. Pierson Construction Company for Point One Investments, LLC at the Grandview Court Development on Georgetown Road in Carneys Point Township.
