**BUCK ROAD CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE ANNOUNCED**

(PITTSGROVE TOWNSHIP, NJ)—Freeholder Deputy Director, Bruce Bobbitt, today announced the revised construction schedule for the Buck Road (County Road 553) Phase I Project from Olivet Road to Willow Grove Road.

“This project is the result of the 2002 County Aid,” said Deputy Director Bobbitt. “Buck Road was selected through the County Engineer’s pavement management program in which we prioritize the roads according to the condition they are in and the amount of traffic they handle.”

Important Dates: October 18<sup>th</sup> - Beginning of clearing of trees and brush, October 24<sup>th</sup> - Beginning of drainage installation, November 12<sup>th</sup> - Beginning of roadway excavation for shoulders, and November 19<sup>th</sup> - Beginning of roadway construction (milling & paving).

“The Buck Road Project in Pittsgrove is part of the Salem County Freeholders continuing efforts to improve the quality of life for the residents of Salem County,” said Deputy Director Bobbitt. “It is essential to our residents and businesses that we are proactive in maintaining our roadways.”

The Salem County Engineer’s office will manage the project, employing the services of Arawak Paving Company Inc. out of Hammonton, NJ.
