

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

COUNTY OF SALEM, NEW JERSEY

The Salem County Purchasing Agent requests sealed proposals for Providing Services to at-risk youth and juveniles that are involved with the family court system. Funding is made through the Juvenile Justice Commission, the Family Court Services Program, and the Juvenile Justice Accountability Block Grant Program (JABG).

Request for Proposal packages may be obtained daily between 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM from the Salem County Purchasing Department, Salem County Administration Building, 94 Market Street, Salem, New Jersey, or they will be mailed on telephone request (856) 935-7510 extension 8499.

A Pre-Bid meeting will be held by appointment with the Salem County Mental Health Director on January 20, 2009. Appointments can be made by calling the Mental Health Department at 856-935-7510 x 8618.

Proposals shall be made and submitted in the manner detailed and prescribed in the Request for Proposal package. They shall be enclosed in sealed envelopes bearing the legend, **“Proposal for Providing Services to at-risk youth and juveniles for the County of Salem”** on the outside. The proposals shall be returned to the Salem County Purchasing Agent by February 5, 2009, 11:00 AM prevailing time, when they will be opened and read in public. Late proposal submissions will not be considered.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, C. 127 (N.J.A.C. 17:27) Affirmative Action.
