DETOUR FOR REPAIR OF A SEWER MAIN ON NORTH HOOK ROAD

(PENNSVILLE, NJ)—Freeholder Bruce Bobbitt, Chair of the County Public Works Committee, today announced that commencing on Thursday, January 14, 2010 work will begin by Pennsville Sewage Authority to repair a sewer main on North Hook Road (CR-551) in Pennsville Township.

“There is a blockage in their sewer pipe that runs down the center of Hook Road from the Italian Kitchen to near King Street,” said Freeholder Bobbitt. “The repair project is expected to last approximately three weeks.”

Project will include excavation and replacement of about 400 feet of terracotta pipe and the repair of the roadway. All truck traffic is to use Route 49 as their detour route. The road will be closed in the vicinity of the Italian Kitchen and the detour will be clearly marked with flaggers to assist traffic in the area.

“As usual, residents will always have access to their homes and businesses and emergency vehicles will be allowed through,” said Freeholder Bobbitt. “To expedite the job the construction crew will work 10 hour days and weekends.”
