## RESOLUTION FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS Act LAW FOR THE COUNTY OF SALEM

**WHEREAS**, Public Law 1975, Chapter 231, Open Public Meetings Act Law was enacted into law on October 21, 1975, and took effect on January 19, 1976; and

**WHEREAS**, the declared purpose of the Open Public Meetings Act Law and also referred to as the "Sunshine Law", is to insure the rights of all citizens have advance notice of and to attend all meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting the public is discussed or acted upon, with certain limited exceptions to protect the public interest and preserve personal privacy; and

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders does hereby wish to comply with the general requirements of the law;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders does hereby establish the following schedule of regular meetings to be held by the said Board during the year 2014 in the Olde Salem Court House 104 Market Street, Salem, New Jersey, 08079, unless otherwise specified, to wit April 16 at Elmer Borough Hall, 102 South Main Street, Elmer, New Jersey; July 16 at Upper Pittsgrove Township Municipal Building, 431 Route #77, Pole Tavern Circle, Elmer, New Jersey; September 3 at Pilesgrove Township Municipal Building, 1180 Route 40, Pilesgrove, New Jersey and October 15 at Alloway Township Municipal Building, 49 South Greenwich Street, Alloway, New Jersey. All meetings will begin with a Freeholder Workshop at 6:15 PM followed by regular meeting at 7:30 PM unless otherwise specified to wit: January 8, 6:00 PM and December 31, will begin at 4:00 PM:
