

## **Salem County Board of Taxation**

The February 10th, 2016 Monthly Meeting of the Salem County Board of Taxation was called to order by President Steven Caltabiano at 8:30 AM.

Compliance with The Open Public Meeting Act was recognized. A roll call of Tax Board members indicated that all members were present. Also in attendance were Tax Administrator John Snyder and Kathy McAllister Administrative Clerk.

In the Administrator's Report John Snyder reviewed the Preliminary Equalization Table with the Commissioners .After review and discussion the Board approved and certified. Hall/Connor 4-0.

Kathy McAllister distributed updated hours and contact information for Salem County Tax Assessors, Tax Collector's and Municipal Solicitor's.

In the President's Report Steven Caltabiano advised the Commissioner's and the Administrator that Tax Appeal Hearings will again be held this year on Tuesday nights in the Salem County Courthouse, 92 Market St., Salem City, in April, May and June, commencing at 5:00PM until conclusion.

Under Old Business Marie Procacci, Salem City Tax Assessor updated the Board on Revaluation Progress presenting the Revaluation Compliance Report (RCR) for Commissioner review and comment. The Board was satisfied with progress to date and thanked Ms. Procacci for the update.

During Public Comment Councilman John Hall from Woodstown informed the Board that 10 homes were sold in town during January, indicating an uptick of interest in residential properties in the community.
