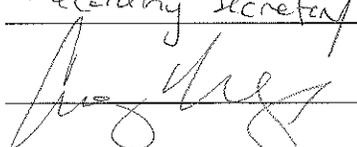

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Capital Budget for the Pollution Control Financing Authority of Salem County for the fiscal year beginning, February 1, 2016 and ending, January 31, 2017 has been presented before the governing body of the Pollution Control Financing Authority of Salem County at its open public meeting of January 5, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$175,000.00, Total Appropriations, including any Accumulated Deficit if any, of \$110,313.00 and Total Unrestricted Net Position utilized of \$0.00; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget as introduced reflects Total Capital Appropriations of \$1,000,000.00 and Total Unrestricted Net Position planned to be utilized as funding thereof, of \$1,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the schedule of rates, fees and other charges in effect will produce sufficient revenues, together with all other anticipated revenues to satisfy all obligations to the holders of bonds of the Authority, to meet operating expenses, capital outlays, debt service requirements, and to provide for such reserves, all as may be required by law, regulation or terms of contracts and agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget/Program, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:31-2, does not confer any authorization to raise or expend funds; rather it is a document to be used as part of the said Authority's planning and management objectives. Specific authorization to expend funds for the purposes described in this section of the budget, must be granted elsewhere; by bond resolution, by a project financing agreement, by resolution appropriating funds from the Renewal and Replacement Reserve or other means provided by law.

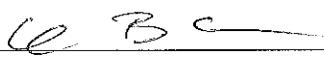
