## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SALEM COUNTY BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS AND CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES OF SALEM COUNTY FOR THE PROVISION OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES UNDER VARIOUS PROGRAMS

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders has received funds from New Jersey Transit under the Senior Citizen and Disabled Resident Transportation Assistance Act, FTA 5311 Non-urbanized Transportation and Salem County Health and Wellness Program to provide transportation to eligible residents in Salem County, and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Salem wishes to provide funds to Penns Grove Borough, Pennsville Township, Pittsgrove Township, and Lower Alloways Creek Township for the purpose of providing Senior and Disabled Transportation & FTA 5311 Non-urbanized Transportation for eligible county residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the funding shall not exceed the following \$30,000 for the Senior Citizen and Disabled Resident Transportation Assistance Program, \$15,000 for FTA 5311 Non-urbanized Transportation funds and \$3,750 from Salem County Health and Wellness Program. These agreements will be funded at these levels providing funding is not interrupted, eliminated, or reduced. Agreements shall be modified in keeping with any changes; and

**WHEREAS**, the municipalities of Penns Grove Borough, Pennsville Township, Pittsgrove Township, and Lower Alloways Creek Township have agreed to accept said amounts in order to provide said transportation pursuant to the terms in the agreement attached,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS AS FOLLOWS:** the County of Salem does hereby authorize the execution of agreements with said municipalities; such agreements shall be in a form acceptable to County Counsel. The contract shall be for the period retroactive to January 1, 2018 through February 15, 2018.

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders wishes to enter into an agreement with Mid-Atlantic States Career and Education Center for a program designed to provide transportation for residents of Salem County for Curb to Curb service; and
