2019 GRANT DOLLARS FROM THE NEW JERSEY HISTORICAL COMMISSION AND  
THE NEW JERSEY STATE COUNCIL FOR THE ARTS**


**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Board of Freeholders through the Salem County Cultural & Heritage Commission was awarded grant money from the New Jersey Historical Commission, a division of the New Jersey Department of State; and the New Jersey State Council for the Arts, a division of the New Jersey Department of State; and

**WHEREAS**, New Jersey Historical Commission has awarded Salem County the sum of \$14,310 for 2019 Local History Programming (CHPP grant) for the purpose of re-granting to local history programs and promote Salem County history; and

**WHEREAS**, New Jersey State Council for the Arts has awarded Salem County the sum of \$46,843 for 2019 Local Arts Programming for the purpose of re-granting to local arts programs to enrich the cultural life of Salem County.

**WHEREAS**, the total of these two grant funds, \$61,153, will greatly assist many local history and arts programs in Salem County during 2019.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem hereby agrees with the recommendations of Salem County Cultural & Heritage Commission and accepts the grant awards of the New Jersey Historical Commission and the New Jersey State Council for the Arts.


The New Jersey Historical Commission has completed its review of the awards for the FY 2019 County History Partnership Program. I am pleased to inform you that the Commission has approved a grant of \$14,310. As we enter into the third year of the program, the Commission is very pleased with your commitment to outreach to new organizations and for helping to grow more established groups.

In 2018 one of the outcomes of the Commission's review of the program was that we will require that no county disqualify an organization from seeking re-grant funds for having an operating budget greater than \$100,000, as long as all other eligibility requirements have been met. Please also note that an organization with a budget of \$100,000 or more may decide if it will apply to either the state or the county. An organization may not receive funds from the state and the county in the same fiscal year. If you have questions about this or any other aspect of the program please be in touch with the Commission.

Very soon you will be receiving notification of the availability of your contract. You will complete your contract and payment voucher on the System for Administering Grants Electronically (SAGE). You will receive an email notifying you when the contract and payment voucher are available. You will recall that the new grant period for the CHPP program matches the calendar year. Even though most of you will be unable to spend the money before January 1, 2019, please complete and submit your contract no later than September 28, 2018. It is essential that you return these documents quickly so that the grant funds are encumbered. Delay on your part risks the loss of the grant.

Once again, the Commission thanks you for all of your outreach efforts and for the work you have done to either launch or continue your re-grant programs. We want to remind you to take a few minutes to contact Governor Phillip Murphy, Secretary Tahesha Way, and your legislators to thank them for their support.
