RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN NEW JERSEY TRANSIT AND THE SALEM COUNTY BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS FOR THE FUNDING OF THE SENIOR AND DISABLED RESIDENT TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE ACT

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders wishes to enter into an agreement with the New Jersey Transit Corporation for a program designed to provide transportation for senior citizens and disabled residents of Salem County under the Senior Citizen and Disabled Resident Transportation Assistance Act; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Transit Corporation is to provide \$332,284.00 for the 2018 fiscal year and a carryover amount of \$201,511.66 from the fiscal year 2016; and


WHEREAS, the total amount will not exceed \$533,795.66 in funding for such a program and the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders is to provide such transportation through the Salem County Office on Aging and Disabilities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem as follows:

1. The Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders accepts the agreement


