RESOLUTION APPROVING PARTICIPATION WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY GRANT PROGRAMS ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE, STATE OFFICE OF VICTIM-WITNESS ADVOCACY (GRANT NO. VCS-60-15)

WHEREAS, the Attorney General has been designated by the Governor to implement the grant programs under the State Office of Victim-Witness Advocacy; and

WHEREAS, the State Office of Victim-Witness Advocacy has elected to administer a grant for the Victims of Crimes Act for the period of October 1, 2016 through March 31, 2018 (extended to August 31, 2018); and,

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders previously granted approval of the application for this grant by Resolution No. 16-356 dated October 19, 2016, and, thereafter, accepted funding from this grant by Resolution No. 17-262 dated September 6, 2017; and


WHEREAS, this resolution is required by the funding agency for the expenditure of funds in the amount of \$175,000.00 from this grant for the purchase of Victim-Witness InfoShare Modules from SHI International (Vendor No. 1886) pursuant to State Contract No. 89851 in order to provide continued Victim-Witness Advocacy services currently provided for the victims and witnesses of criminal investigations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem wishes to approve said expenditure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem as follows:

1. As a matter of policy, the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem wishes to participate to the fullest extent possible with the Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Criminal Justice, State Office of Victim-Witness Advocacy.
2. The Attorney General will receive funds on behalf of all prospective sub-grantees.
3. The Division of Criminal Justice is authorized to initiate allocations to each sub-grantee.
4. The Board of Chosen Freeholders approves the aforesaid expenditure.

5. Four (4) fully certified copies of this resolution shall be forwarded to the County Prosecutor forthwith.
