**Resolution Authorizing the Proposed Acquisition of a Development Easement on Mary Louise Morda Farm Pilesgrove Township**

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Agriculture Development Board submitted a Planning Incentive Grant (PIG) application to the State Agriculture Development Committee (SADC), pursuant to the State Agriculture Retention and Development Act, N.J.S.A. 4:1C-11 et. Seq., the Planning Incentive Grant Program, N.J.S.A. 4:1C-43.1, and the regulations there under; and

**WHEREAS**, the application provided for the proposed acquisition of a Development Easement on the property owned by Mary Louise Morda and designated on the municipal tax map as Block 21, Lot 6 in the Township of Pilesgrove, County of Salem, State of New Jersey; and


**WHEREAS**, the State Agriculture Development Committee certified the fair market value of the development easement pursuant to N.J.A.C. 2:76-7.14 at \$8,500 per acre on December 7, 2017. The estimated cost sharing breakdown for the acquisition of the development easement is as follows (based on an estimated 86.47 net acres), subject to (a) the actual acreage to be covered by the development easement per the final survey which conforms to the farmland preservation program requirements, and (b) any additional adjustments pursuant to the State statute rule, regulation or policy:

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Agriculture Development Board gave final approval to the proposed acquisition of a development easement on the Mary Louise Morda Farm, Block 21, Lot 6 in the township of Pilesgrove, on approximately 86.47 net acres at its June 27, 2018 meeting and is subject to the following:

- (a) The conveyance of a development easement which shall provide for the following:
  1. Exception: Two (2) acre non severable area along Kings Highway for a future residential dwelling
  2. Non-Agricultural use(s): None
  3. Dwellings: None
  4. Residual Dwelling Site Opportunities: None

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders authorizes the proposed acquisition of a development easement on the Mary Louise Morda in an amount of approximately \$0.
