**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY
OFFICE OF THE INSURANCE FRAUD PROSECUTOR FOR THE
PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE INSURANCE FRAUD REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Office of the Insurance Fraud Prosecutor has been designated by the Legislature to implement funding reimbursement for anti-insurance fraud activities, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-28; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Prosecutor's Office has received funding for anti-insurance fraud activities and wishes to apply for continued funding in the amount of \$250,000.00 for an action plan under the reimbursement program beginning January 1, 2019 and running through December 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Chosen Freeholders ("Board") recognizes the need to assist the Prosecutor's Office, the New Jersey Office of Insurance Fraud Prosecutor and law enforcement in an endeavor to effectively address the problem of insurance fraud in this County; and

WHEREAS, the project is a joint effort between the Office of the Insurance Fraud Prosecutor and the Salem County Prosecutor's Office for the purposes described in the application; and

WHEREAS, this agreement shall further be contingent upon availability and appropriation of sufficient funds for this purpose in the County's temporary and/or permanent budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Chosen Freeholders has reviewed the application on file with the Clerk of the Board and has approved said request;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem that:

1. The project grant on file with the Clerk of the Board is approved and accepted.
2. The Attorney General has allocated funds dedicated for the purpose of reimbursing County Prosecutors for anti-insurance fraud activities.
3. The Office of the Insurance Fraud Prosecutor shall be responsible for the receipt, review and approval of the applications for said funding.
4. The Office of the Insurance Fraud Prosecutor shall initiate allocations to each applicant as authorized.

5. Five fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the County Prosecutor forthwith.
