RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2018-320 AND ACCEPTING REMAINING FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY FOR THE 2018-2019 LOCAL CORE CAPACITY INFRASTRUCTURE FOR BIOTERRORISM PREPAREDNESS

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders applied for and obtained a grant from the State of New Jersey to provide a cohesive plan against disease occurrences, natural disasters or acts of terrorism for the residents of Salem County; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services has made the remaining funds in the amount of \$100,000 available, in addition to the approved funded amount of \$165,340, stated in Resolution 2018-320; and

WHEREAS, the total funded amount of the 2018-2019 Local Core Capacity Infrastructure for Bioterrorism Preparedness Grant is \$265,340, for the period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem to hereby execute and accept the remaining funds from the State of New Jersey for the 2018-2019 Local Core Capacity Infrastructure for Bioterrorism Preparedness.
