**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TERMINATION OF  
THREE VEHICLE LEASES BETWEEN THE  
COUNTY OF SALEM AND NEW JERSEY TRANSIT**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Salem has an existing lease agreement with New Jersey Transit to maintain and operate three transportation vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the leases for the three vehicles with New Jersey Transit have reached their 5 year expiration date according to the grant and the leases will be terminated; and

**WHEREAS**, terminating the following vehicle leases, 16-1606 – 1FD4E4FS8DDB16049, 16-1498 – 1FD4E4FS9DDA62888 & 16-1586 – 1FD4E4FS6DDB09665 the County of Salem will retain ownership of these three vehicles for continued use in the Transportation program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem as follows:

1. The County has three existing vehicle leases with New Jersey Transit to maintain and operate each vehicle.
2. The term has expired for each lease and needs to be terminated between the County of Salem and New Jersey Transit.
3. The County of Salem will retain ownership of the three vehicles and use them in the Transportation program.
4. The Freeholder Chairman of Health/ Human Services/ Education Committee is hereby authorized to certify, approve and sign the forms for each vehicle as listed above.

If Agency transfers title or otherwise disposes of the vehicle in any manner, it shall require the new owner of the Vehicle to indemnify, protect and save harmless NJ TRANSIT and its officers, agents and employees in the same manner.

Agency shall follow all state laws and procedures for disposing of the Vehicle. Agency is not required to return to NJ TRANSIT, the State of New Jersey or the FTA, proceeds from the sale of the Vehicle regardless of the fair market value at the time of sale, so long as the proceeds remain in use for the transportation purposes for which the Vehicle was operated under the funding agreement.




