RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FREEHOLDER DIRECTOR AND THE CLERK OF THE BOARD TO SIGN THE HEALTH SERVICE GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE 2019 COMPREHENSIVE ALCOHOL AND DRUG PROJECT

WHEREAS, the New Jersey State Department of Human Services intends to grant the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders funds derived from the Alcoholic Beverage Tax and other State funding under authority of P.L. 1983, Chapter 51; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of Chapter 51 funds awarded under the grant will be \$230,347.00 to be utilized for the provision of alcohol and drug rehabilitation services for Salem County residents; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a cash match of \$18,274.00; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Treasurer has certified that the funding for this grant in 2019 shall be encumbered in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4 and this agreement shall further be contingent upon the availability and appropriation of sufficient funds for the purpose in the County's temporary and/or permanent budget.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem that the Freeholder Director shall be authorized to sign an application for a health service grant for the provision of alcoholism and drug abuse treatment services for the period of January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019.
