RESOLUTION TO APPOINT THE PUBLIC AGENCY COMPLIANCE OFFICER FOR THE COUNTY OF SALEM

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.3, a Public Agency must annually designate an officer to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer (P.A.C.O.); and

WHEREAS, the P.A.C.O. is responsible for assuring that no public contract may be awarded nor any monies paid until the prospective contractor has agreed to contract performance which complies with an approved affirmative action program; and

WHEREAS, the P.A.C.O., as the liaison official for matters concerning P.L. 1975, c.127 (N.J.A.C. 17:27), shall have the authority to make appropriate corrections to the County's contracting procedures if required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem as follows:

- 1. The allegations of the preamble are incorporated herein by this reference.
2. JAMES JOHNSTON is hereby appointed as the Public Agency Compliance Officer for the County of Salem's 2019 fiscal year.
3. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the Department of Treasury, State Affirmative Action Office.
