RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TO ACCEPT FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2018 SUBGRANT AWARD FROM NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY DIVISION OF STATE POLICE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT NO. FY18-EMPG-EMAA-1700 CFDA#:97.042 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$55,000.00

WHEREAS, the Salem County Sheriffs Office of Emergency Management made application to the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management for FY18 Emergency Management Assistance Agency (EMAA) Funding; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Sheriffs Office of Emergency Management has received notice of award from the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of State Police, Office of Emergency Management, for sub grant award No. FY18-EMPG-EMAA-1700 for the period of 7/01/18 through 6/30/19, consisting of a total amount of \$110,699.55 (\$55,000.00 Federal funds and \$55,699.55 Local in-kind Matching funds), to be used for salary, wages, and fringe benefits for the purpose of enhancing and sustaining the County's all hazards emergency management capabilities and enhancing the County's ability to prevent, respond to and recover from acts of terrorism, natural disaster or other catastrophic events.

1. The project funding application as outlined and on file with the Salem County Sheriffs Office of Emergency Management is supported and approved.

The Chief Finance Officer and the contact person from the Salem County Sheriffs Office of Emergency Management, as well as any other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all grant requirements and documentation filings as directed by the New Jersey State Police Emergency Management.
3. Three fully executed copies of the resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Sheriffs Office of Emergency Management forthwith.

Mr. Haines:

After carefully reviewing your application documents submitted for the 2018 Emergency Management Agency Assistance (EMAA) subaward, supported by the FY18 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG), Salem County has been selected to receive a federal award up to \$55,000.00 with a nonfederal match requirement (this match must be equal to or greater than your federal award amount). It has been determined that Salem County is eligible to submit an Award Package which is posted on the NJEMGrants website.

The completed Award Package shall be submitted to the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management (NJOEM) Preparedness Bureau via the NJEMGrants online system. Upon completion of the Performance Period (July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019), approved Work Plan Activities, and Expenditure Certification, reimbursement will be made to the county by the state.

The county is responsible for the required match (dollar-for-dollar), either cash or in-kind, to the federal portion of the award. The source of the match, and the match amount, must be documented in the application (Budget Detail), in the award package (Resolution and Contract Page), and on the required reimbursement forms.
