**RESOLUTION RESTRICTING PARKING ALONG A  
CERTAIN SECTION OF RAILROAD AVENUE,  
COUNTY ROAD #602  
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF OLDMANS,  
COUNTY OF SALEM**

**WHEREAS,** the Township of Oldmans requested a parking restriction along a certain section of Railroad Avenue, County Road #602; and

**WHEREAS,** the Township of Oldmans requested the "No Parking" designation to prohibit Parking, at any time, along the north side only of Railroad Road, County Road #602 from 705 feet west of the intersection with Freed Road, a local road to 13 North Railroad Avenue, County Road #602, which is 335 feet west of the intersection with Mill Street, County Road #642; and


**WHEREAS,** the Township of Oldmans has requested the "NO PARKING ZONE" to protect and increase the safety and welfare of the general public, emergency vehicles and the children while walking to and from school along Railroad Avenue, County Road #602; and

**WHEREAS,** the County Engineer has investigated this section of Railroad Avenue, County Road #602 and recommends the following restrictions.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders that parking be and is hereby restricted, at any time, along the north side of Railroad Avenue, County Road #602:

1. More particularly described as being located along the north side of Railroad Avenue, County Road #602, beginning at a point 705 feet west of the intersection with Freed Road, a local road and running northwest to a point 335 feet west of the intersection with Mill Street, County Road #642.
2. That the Salem County Road Supervisor be and is authorized to erect the proper signage as required by law with installation conforming to the standards set forth in the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices".
3. That the Salem County Road Supervisor be and is hereby authorized to restripe to adjust the position of the centerline along the aforementioned section of Railroad Avenue, County Road #602.
4. That the Salem County Road Supervisor be and is authorized to paint the north curb, along the entire length of the aforementioned section of Railroad Avenue, County Road #602 - "Yellow" to indicate "No Parking".

5. A duly certified copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
