**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DEDICATION
OF A PORTION OF
QUINTON-ALLOWAY ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #581,
IN QUINTON TOWNSHIP
IN MEMORY OF
NEW JERSEY STATE POLICE TROOPER ELI MCCARSON #7775**

WHEREAS, the County of Salem received Resolution No. 2019-54 adopted by Quinton Township, requesting the dedication of a portion of Quinton-Alloway Road, County Road #581 in memory of New Jersey State Police Trooper Eli McC Carson, badge #7775; and

WHEREAS, State Trooper McC Carson was an extraordinary public servant who was stationed at the Woodstown Barracks of the New Jersey State Police and served the residents of Quinton Township and the County of Salem with honor; and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2015, State Trooper McC Carson tragically lost his life in a motor vehicle accident while conducting a domestic violence investigation on Quinton-Alloway Road, County Road #581 in the vicinity of Waterworks Road, a local road, in Quinton Township; and

WHEREAS, State Trooper McC Carson was a dedicated member of the New Jersey State Police whose memory will live on in the hearts of his family, friends and fellow State Troopers; and

WHEREAS, as a true example of leadership and service to the County of Salem, it is fitting and proper for the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem to honor the memory of State Trooper McC Carson by designating the portion of Quinton-Alloway Road, County Road #581 in the Township of Quinton as the "State Trooper Eli McC Carson Memorial Highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders that a portion of Quinton-Alloway Road, County Road #581, in the vicinity of Waterworks Road, a local road, be Dedicated to the Memory of New Jersey State Trooper Eli McC Carson, #7775; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Quinton Township may, with the guidance of the Salem County Road Supervisor, install the sign, provided by Quinton Township dedicating said portion of Quinton-Alloway Road, County Road #581 to the Memory of New Jersey State Trooper, Eli McC Carson, #7775.
