RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF ONE 1989 IMPERIAL FIRE TRUCK FROM FROM THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSAUKEN

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of Pennsauken has determined that a 1989 Imperial Fire Truck PRMFAB/GRUMMAN 1500 GPM Fire Engine bearing the vehicle identification number 1P1F1 05B3C AO890 06 is no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem Office of Emergency Management has expressed an interest in acquiring the fire truck for use by the Salem County Fire Academy as a training aid; and

WHEREAS, N.J. S.A. 40A:12-21.1 permits the sale of municipal property to the County without compliance with any other law governing disposal of personal property by Counties or Municipalities, for a consideration, which may be nominal.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem that:

1. The County accepts the 1989 Imperial Fire Truck PRMFAB/GRUMMAN 1500 GPM Fire Engine bearing the vehicle identification number 1P1F1 05B3C AO890 06 in return for the payment of One Dollar (\$1.00).
2. The County Purchasing Agent is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the transfer of said fire engine, including the transfer the NJ Department of Motor Vehicles Title and to make provisions for insurance.
