**RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2019-302 FOR OPERATION HELPING HAND REIMBURSEMENT GRANT (Subaward No. OHH-17-2019) FOR THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Chosen Freeholders (Board) previously adopted Resolution 2019-302 on August 14, 2019, accepting and executing Operation Helping Hand Reimbursement Grant;

**WHEREAS**, said Resolution omitted Subaward No. OHH-17-2019 and incorrectly accepted and executed said grant, rather than authorizing a grant application submission;

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Prosecutor's Office wishes to apply for and has submitted an application for funding in the amount of \$100,000.00 for Operation Helping Hand Initiatives under the reimbursement program for a period of one year, beginning September 1, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board recognizes the need to assist the Prosecutor's Office, the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety and law enforcement in an endeavor to effectively address the opioid crisis in Salem County; and

**WHEREAS**, the project is a joint effort between the Department of Law and Public Safety and the Salem County Prosecutor's Office for the purposes described in the application.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem that:

- 1) The project grant application on file with the Clerk of the Board has been reviewed and approved by the Board of Chosen Freeholders
- 2) The Attorney General has allocated funding, dedicated for the purpose of reimbursing County Prosecutors for Operation Helping Hand Initiative activities.
- 3) The County Prosecutor, the Chief Finance Officer, the Project Contact person from the Prosecutor's Office, as well as any other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all project grant documents provided by the Division.
- 4) Five fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the County Prosecutor forthwith.
