**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS AUTHORIZING THE EXTENTION OF A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SALEM AND THE SALEM COUNTY VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL SCHOOL FOR A BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS INSPIRING DREAMS AND GROWTH EMPLOYMENT (B.R.I.D.G.E.) OPPORTUNITIES PROGRAM 2020**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Chosen Freeholders ("Board") recognizes a continuing need to assist the Salem County Youth Services Commission ("SCYSC") and county Council on Juvenile Justice System Improvement ("CJJSI") in efforts to provide approved Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative ("JDAI") Innovations programming for youth adjudicated delinquent; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Salem applied for, received and accepted a New Jersey Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative Innovation Funding Grant ("Grant") for CY 2020 in the total amount of \$120,000.00 (One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents); and

**WHEREAS**, the SCYSC and CJJSI approved a grant application from the New Jersey Juvenile Justice Commission for the 2020 JDAI Grant Program in accordance with the certified assurances, grant conditions, award notice on file with the Clerk of the Board ; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 7, 2019 the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders authorized a Shared Services Agreement with the Salem County Vocational and Technical School ("SCVT") by Resolution 2019-120; and

**WHEREAS**, said Shared Services Agreement contained an option to extend the term of the Agreement contingent upon satisfactory implementation of the BRIDGE program in 2019 and continued funding for the program from the New Jersey Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative Innovations Funding Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board recognizes the success of the 2019 BRIDGE program and Salem County Vocational-Technical School ("School") as an approved JDAI funding grantee in the amount of Sixty-Eight Thousand, Four Hundred and Eighty-Eight Dollars and Zero Cents (\$68,488.00) to facilitate the Building Relationships Inspiring Dreams and Growing Employment Opportunities (B.R.I.D.G.E) Program for at-risk youth via a shared services agreement. The Board recognizes the grant reimbursement contract is for a one year period starting January 1, 2020 and terminating December 31, 2020;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem that:

1. The Shared Services Agreement between the County of Salem and the Salem County Vocational-Technical School for a Building Relationships Inspiring Dreams and Growing Employment Opportunities (B.R.I.D.G.E) Program is hereby extended, contingent upon continued funding for the program from the New Jersey Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative Innovations Funding Program and satisfactory performance of the SCVT with the B.R.I.D.G.E. program.
2. The term of the Shared Services Agreement on file in the Purchasing Department is hereby extended with the same terms and conditions outlined therein.
3. The B.R.I.D.G.E Program Summary on file with the Clerk of the Board is approved and accepted.

4. The Deputy Director of Operations, the Chief Finance Officer, the Salem County Youth Services Coordinator from the Salem Inter Agency Council of Human Services Inc., as well as any other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all project grant documents provided by the Juvenile Justice Commission.
5. Three fully executed copies of this resolution shall be provided to the Salem County Inter Agency Council of Human Services and one fully executed copy shall be provided to the Salem County Vocational Technical School and one fully executed copy shall be provided to the Salem County Purchasing Department to file with the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.
