RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE NEW JERSEY JUDICIARY CUMBERLAND/GLOUCESTER/SALEM VICINAGE AND THE COUNTY OF SALEM FOR PROBATION ENRICHMENT AND TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM 2020

WHEREAS, the County of Salem applied for, received and accepted a New Jersey Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative Innovation Funding Grant ("Grant") for CY 2020 in the total amount of \$120,000.00 (One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents); and

WHEREAS, the grant includes a component for Probation Enrichment and Transportation Program in the total amount of \$45,512.00 (Forty-Five Thousand, Five Hundred and Twelve Dollars and Zero cents); and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Grant Salem County must contract directly with the State of New Jersey Judiciary, Cumberland/Gloucester/Salem Vicinage to provide payments for Orientation and Probation Officer Overtime Stipends totaling \$7,425.00 (Seven Thousand, Four Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars and Zero Cents); and


WHEREAS, the Salem County Treasurer has certified that funding for this Agreement shall be encumbered in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4 and this agreement shall further be contingent upon the availability and appropriation of sufficient funds contained in the 2020 Temporary and Final Budget of the County of Salem under the item JDAI-Probation Enrichment Transportation Program (G-02-41-765-20C-303).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem as follows:

1. The Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem authorizes an Agreement New Jersey Judiciary, Cumberland/Gloucester/Salem Vicinage to provide payments for Orientation and Probation Officer Overtime Stipends totaling \$7,425.00 (Seven Thousand, Four Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars and Zero Cents); subject to the review of County Counsel and AOC Counsel.
2. The Agreement shall commence January 1, 2020 and terminate December 31, 2020, which shall be completed in full accordance with the terms and conditions of the Grant.
3. The Freeholder Director and the Clerk of the Board shall be authorized to execute said contracts.
