## **RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR FURNISHING, INSTALLING, SUPPLYING AND SERVICING VENDING MACHINES FOR THE COUNTY OF SALEM**

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Purchasing Agent, as authorized contracting Agent for the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem has requested, received and opened sealed proposals on December 17, 2019 at 11:00 AM prevailing time for Furnishing, Installing, Supplying and Servicing Vending Machines for the County of Salem. The receipt of said bids were duly advertised in accordance with the law and in such case made and provided; and

**WHEREAS**, all bid results and recommendations are on file in the Office of the Purchasing Agent, 110 Fifth Street, Suite 400, Salem, New Jersey, as required by Law; and

**WHEREAS**, it was determined that the company of Four M Vending Service, Pennsville, NJ, substantially met the necessary qualifications for the fulfillment of the contract, and further provided the documentation necessary to successfully fulfill the requirements of the County of Salem. Said bid documents shall become a part of the contract: and

**WHEREAS**, The Salem County Treasurer will not need to certify funding for this contract as it is a commission based concession contract with no cost to the County of Salem; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem as follows:

1. The Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem hereby awards a contract for Furnishing, Installing, Supplying and Servicing Vending Machines for the County of Salem, subject to the review of the County Solicitor, to Four M Vending Service, 163 North Broadway, Suite 2, Pennsville, NJ 08070.
2. The contract shall commence December 31, 2019 and terminate December 30, 2020 with, with two (2) one (1) year renewal options available pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15 (45). This shall be completed in full accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract.
3. The proposal further provides for a 15% commission paid to the County of Salem on all vending machine purchases made during the term of the contract.

4. The Freeholder Director and the Clerk of the Board shall be authorized to execute said contract upon compliance by the firm with all requirements and specifications.
