RESOLUTION TO APPOINT COUNSEL FOR BAIL FORFEITURE

WHEREAS, the County of Salem has a need to acquire bail forfeiture counsel services; and

WHEREAS, the value of the contract will not exceed the Local Public Contract Law bid threshold of \$17,500.00, and N.J.S.A. 40a:11-5(A) permits such professional services contracts to not have been subject to public bidding; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated term of this contract is one year and may be extended if approved by this governing body; and


WHEREAS, it has been determined that Linwood Donelson of the firm Donelson, D’Alessandro, and Peterson, LLC. can provide the legal expertise required as bail forfeiture counsel for the County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem authorizes the Director to enter into a contract with Linwood Donelson, Esq. Attorney at Law of the firm Donelson, D’Alessandro, and Peterson, LLC. confirming his appointment to perform bail forfeiture legal work for a one year term in consideration in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 annually.
