RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FROM THE NJ ASSOCIATION OF COUNTY AND CITY HEALTH OFFICIALS TO EXPAND OUTREACH, TO EDUCATE AND TO ADDRESS THE HEPATITIS A OUTBREAK

WHEREAS, The Salem County Department of Health and Human Services intends to apply for a Tier 1 Hepatitis A grant in the amount of \$42,850.00; and

WHEREAS, The amount of funding for the project will be contingent on the availability of funds and an approved proposal through the NJ Association of County and City Health Officials. The funding will be used to offset expenses for staff, provide supplies for Hepatitis A immunizations and testing, and provide education and outreach; and

WHEREAS, The Salem County Health Department intends to partner with the Vineland City Health Department to access vaccines and enhance outreach and education; and

WHEREAS, The Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders recognizes the Agreement is for the Project period of December 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem that the Freeholder Director and the Clerk of the Board are authorized to sign the Resolution applying for the NJ Association of County and City Health Officials Hepatitis A grant application.
