RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GRANT APPLICATIONS TO THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS DIVISION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES FOR THE LOCAL EFFICIENCY ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM (LEAP)

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders approved Resolution 2019-481 establishing a fair and open process for the awarding of a professional services contract for a unified Salem County School District Feasibility Study; and
