**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING
A GRANT FROM THE NEW JERSEY DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE
FOR THE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE [MEGAN'S LAW JAG 1-17-17]**

WHEREAS, the Board of Chosen Freeholders ("Board") recognizes the need to assist the Prosecutor's Office and the New Jersey Division of Criminal Justice ("Division") in continuing the administrative functions relevant to the enforcement of Megan's Law; and

WHEREAS, the Division has approved the grant application identified as Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG 1-17-17) from the Prosecutor's Office for the continued administration efforts of Megan's Law in accordance with the grant acceptance letter attached hereto and on file with the Clerk of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the Grant is for the period of January 15, 2018 through January 14, 2019, with funding of \$4,073.00 appropriated in Federal monies under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program with a local match of \$2,106.00, totaling \$6,179.00; and

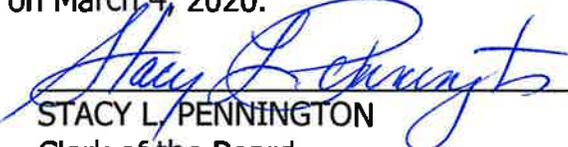
