**RESOLUTION CONVERTING AN ESTABLISHED SNOW REMOVAL RESERVE TO STORM RECOVERY RESERVE FOR CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Salem previously established a snow removal reserve per NJSA 4A:4-62.1; and

**WHEREAS**, NJSA 4A:4-62.1 permits a municipality or county to adopt a resolution authorizing reserve funds to be used for "any purpose necessary to protect the safety, security, health, and welfare, of its citizens from the damage caused by an emergency declared by the Governor or the President of the United States"; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governor declared a state of emergency via Executive Order 103 on March 9, 2020.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem that the County may use funds in the snow removal reserve for Coronavirus Response.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that any reimbursement of these expenditures shall be deposited back into the reserve.
