**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SOUTH JERSEY BAYSHORE COALITION'S SUBMISSION FOR DESIGNATION OF THE BAYSHORE HERITAGE BYWAY AS AN ALL-AMERICAN ROAD**

**WHEREAS**, on July 22, 2009 the New Jersey Department of Transportation announced the designation of the South Jersey Bayshore Heritage Byway as an official Scenic Byway; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bayshore Heritage Byway is 142 mile long route through South Jersey's western shore through 19 municipalities within Salem, Cumberland and Cape May Counties and includes natural and historic points of interest specific to Salem County including Fort Mott and Finn's Point Cemetery, Historic Salem City, the Hancock House, Alloway Creek Watershed Site, and Millspond and Madhorse Creek Fish and Wildlife Management Areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Salem, by and through its Board of Chosen Freeholders, wishes to express its support for the federal designation of the Bayshore Heritage Byway as an All-American Road to enhance recognition of the County's natural and historic heritage.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem, as follows;

That this Board hereby expresses its support of the South Hersey Bayshore Coalition and its intention to submit an application to the Federal Highway Administration for designation of Bayshore Heritage Byway as an All-American Road.
