RESOLUTION EXTENDING A CONTRACT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS' AFFAIRS FOR THE PROVISION OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR VETERANS FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2020 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2020

WHEREAS, a contract was executed with the Department of Veterans' and Military Affairs for funding transportation services for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the COVID 19 pandemic severely impacted veteran's health services; and

WHEREAS, the NJ Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs wishes to continue counseling services to veterans without lapse in their health care requirements; and

WHEREAS, the NJ Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs wishes to extend the transportation contract to through September 30, 2020 under the same terms and conditions as the original contract dated July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem that the Director and the Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized to execute said contract extension with the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs.
