**RESOLUTION FOR EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION-UNUSUAL STORM EVENT IN THE COUNTY OF SALEM**

**WHEREAS**, on or about August 7, 2020, an unusual storm event emergency occurred in the County of Salem as well as in portions of Woolwich Township in Gloucester County, necessitating immediate emergency repairs, including but not limited to immediate site evaluation, other associated services and immediate site repair and for which no adequate provisions were made in the 2020 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-46 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purposes mentioned above; and

**WHEREAS**, the total amount of the emergency appropriations created, including the appropriation to be created by this resolution is \$2,000,000.00; and


**WHEREAS**, three (3) percent of the total operating appropriations in the County Budget for 2020 is \$2,414,074.92; and

**WHEREAS**, the foregoing appropriation, together with any prior appropriations, does not exceed three (3) percent of the total operating appropriations in the budget for 2020; and


**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders now desires to make an emergency appropriation its 2020 Budget in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 to make necessary repairs for damage stemming from an unusual storm event occurring on August 7, 2020;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:4-48:

1. An emergency appropriation is hereby made for emergency repairs in the County of Salem and portions of Woolwich Township in Gloucester County, in the amount of \$2,000,000.00; and
2. That said emergency appropriation shall be provided for in full in the 2021 budget, and is requested to be excluded from CAPS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53.3c(1); and
3. That two (2) certified copies of this resolution be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services
