
**RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT FUNDING FROM NEW JERSEY TRANSIT FOR

WHEREAS, under this program, Office on Aging & Disabilities has received funding under New Jersey Cares Act Section 5311 Non-Urbanized Transportation in the amount of \$618,957.00 (Six Hundred Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Seven Dollars and Zero Cents) beginning March 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 with no required match.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem that:

Dear Ms. Bradway:

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES) or PL116-136 was signed into law on March 27, 2020, and provided certain economic assistance to public transportation providers. The CARES grant provides 100% federal reimbursement for eligible expenses; therefore, no subrecipient match funding is required. As per the NJ TRANSIT's State Management Plan (SMP) that documents the State's Section 5311 funding distribution process, the distribution of CARES ACT funding is based on rural area in New Jersey, therefore your agency request for funds is **not to exceed \$618,957.00.**

As you requested, this letter will confirm the Federal Transit Administration's Section 5311 Program funds allocated to the County of Salem for Fiscal Year 2020. The County of Salem has been allocated these federal funds for the period of March 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020. Current Section 5311 program appropriations will be reserved for future Section 5311 program expenditures once CARES ACT funds have been fully expended.

This letter shall allow the County of Salem to take appropriate actions to plan for the continuance of service.
