**RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE PROPOSED REALLOCATION OF FUNDING FROM THE STATE RECYCLING FUND**

**WHEREAS**, essential recycling services are mandated under State law; and

**WHEREAS**, the State Recycling Fund provides an estimated \$24 million to municipalities and counties to fund mandated recycling services; and

**WHEREAS**, the international and domestic recycling markets are in crisis causing higher tipping fees for the disposal of recycling; and

**WHEREAS**, the impact of COVID 19 has substantially increased residential recycling generation rates due to work from home policies and orders; and

**WHEREAS**, Municipal and County budgets will be further strained by the loss of over half the funding.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem urges Governor Murphy to reconsider the reallocation of the State Recycling Fund to Parks Management.
