RESOLUTION AMENDING THE HEPATITIS A GRANT (COVID)

WHEREAS, the Salem county Board of Chosen Freeholders adopted Resolution 2020-099 on March 4, 2020 which Authorized the Acceptance and Executing of the Hepatitis A/COVID grant; and

WHEREAS, said plan originally set aside \$44,586.00 of the NJ Association of County and City Health Officials; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of New Jersey issued Executive Order No. 103 on March 9, 2020 declaring a Public Health Emergency and State of Emergency in response to the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, further actions by the Governor of New Jersey and the COVID-19 Task Force have resulted in the reduction of funding to certain programs throughout the State in order to re-allocate those resources towards the Public Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the County has received notice that the New Jersey Department of Health has authorized additional funding of the Hep A grant commencing February 1, 2020 through July 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding has been awarded in the total amount of \$2,905.72 (Two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Five Dollars and Seventy-two Cents).; and

WHEREAS, this agreement shall further be contingent upon the availability and appropriation of sufficient funds contained in the 2020 Budget of the County of Salem under the item G-02-41-756-20G-303 (HEP A/COVID).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Salem that the Freeholder Chair and the Clerk of the Board hereby approves the amendment to the Hepatitis A/COVID grant to encompass additional funding in the total amount of \$2,905.72 (Two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Five Dollars and Seventy-two Cents).

Hi all. Here is the final number on the additional monies that can be submitted for reimbursement of Covid-19 Pandemic response costs through the HAV grant. Each Sub-grantee now has an additional \$2905.72 to cover costs. This brings your total amount of funds from this grant to \$47,491.72. A reminder, the costs must have been spent after March 23rd and prior to July 31st. I expect you will be using payroll records within those time parameter. I am attaching a blank form which you can use or you can update a previously submitted form with additional data to substantiate reimbursement of the new total.

I am hoping you can work with this information relatively quickly. We must upload all this data prior to August 31st. So, though no fault of yours, I am a bit anxious to move on this as soon as possible. So, please forgive in advance any reminders I start sending as we move to the end of next week.
