**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING A GRANT  
FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020  
LOCAL BRIDGE FUTURE NEEDS PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS,** the Salem County Engineer's Office made application to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for funds from the LOCAL BRIDGE FUTURE NEEDS PROGRAM; and

**WHEREAS,** the Board previously granted approval of the aforesaid application by Resolution No. 2019-418, dated November 6, 2019 and, therefore, approves acceptance and execution of this Grant; and

**WHEREAS,** the New Jersey Department of Transportation has obligated funds for the "2020 LOCAL BRIDGE FUTURE NEEDS PROGRAM" in the amount of \$1,263,291.00 for the specific BRIDGE REHABILITATION AND REPAIR projects listed below:


1. Auburn Bridge, County Bridge #1700-102 on Auburn Road, County Road #551 over Oldmans Creek in Oldmans Township.
2. Hawks Bridge, County Bridge #1700-200 on Hawks Bridge Road, County Road #540 over the Salem Creek in Carneys Point Township.
3. Oliphants Bridge, County Bridge #1700-437 on Kings Highway, County Road #620 over Salem Creek in Pilesgrove Township.
4. Oliphants Mill Bridge, County Bridge #1700-479 on Kings Highway/Sharptown Road, County Road #620 over Oldmans Creek in Pilesgrove Township.
5. Hancock's Bridge, County Bridge #1701-300 on Salem-Hancock's Bridge Road, County Road #658 over Alloways Creek in Lower Alloways Creek Township.
6. Locuson Bridge, County Bridge #1704-136 on Renter Road, a local road, over a Branch of Avis Mill Pond in Pilesgrove Township.
7. Courses Landing Bridge, County Bridge #1704-000 on Pointers-Auburn Road, County Road #646 over Salem Creek in Pilesgrove Township.
8. West Branch Bridge, County Bridge #1713-215 on Stow Neck Road, a local road, over West Branch of Stow Creek in Lower Alloways Creek Township.
9. Richmanville Bridge, County Bridge #1704-123 on Woodstown-Daretown Road, County Road #615 over a branch of Avis Mill Pond in Pilesgrove Township.
10. Avis Mill Camp Crockett, County Bridge #1704-138 on Avis Mill Road, local road, over the Salem Creek in Pilesgrove Township.
11. Avis Mill Bridge, County Bridge #1704-139 on Avis Mill Road, local road, over the Salem Creek in Pilesgrove Township; and

**WHEREAS,** no funding match is required for this Grant; and

**WHEREAS,** this Grant and Projects are to be referenced as the 2020 LOCAL BRIDGE FUTURE NEEDS PROGRAM.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

1. The GRANT AGREEMENT, as received from the New Jersey Department of Transportation, be accepted and executed.
2. The Chief Finance Officer and the contact person from the Salem County Engineer's Office, as well as other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all grant requirements and documentation filings as directed by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

Enclosed is one copy of the executed Agreement approved by the Department of Transportation for the above referenced project in the amount of \$1,263,291.00.

This project will be funded from the New Jersey Transportation Trust Fund Authority Act. State participation in the cost of the project is limited to 100 percent of the cost of the completed construction work including construction supervision, inspection and material testing, or the amount of the allotment, whichever is less.


16:20B-6.2 Contract deadline: (a) Municipal local aid agreements using both formula allocations and urban aid allocations shall specify that a contract must be awarded by the municipality within 24 months from the date of grant notification. At any time, but at a minimum of 30 days prior to the 24-month deadline, a municipality may voluntarily cancel a municipal local aid agreement and release the funds back to the Department.

Failure to make an award by the contract deadline or to comply with the requirements of the Municipal Aid Regulations 16:20B and the Terms and Conditions of Grant Agreement for State Aid to Counties and Municipalities will jeopardize the use of State funds on this project. It is further noted that the project must be in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, ADA, requirements for accessibility. Through the approval of this agreement, the sponsor is required to provide submission updates that are to be tracked through the on-line SAGE System. The Sponsor is also responsible for continued updates with respect to the construction administration/management phase of the project in the SAGE System and the Department's new Project Management Reporting System when it comes on-line for local projects. The preparation of contract documents shall use the current Standard Specifications as amended by the current edition of Special Provisions for Local Aid Projects. All requirements of this program can be found in the State Aid Handbook, available at the above website.
