RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SIGNING OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SALEM AND THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO BE LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF ROUTE 40 AND COURSES LANDING ROAD (CR 628) IN THE TOWNSHIP OF CARNEYS POINT, PROJECT S-40-S-19388-2019 AND A-48-S-19386-2019

WHEREAS, a traffic condition exists at the intersection of Route 40 and Courses Landing Road (CR 628), in the Township of Carneys Point, in the County of Sale, which requires the installation and operation of a semi-actuated traffic control signal with pedestrian push buttons and areas of presence detection; and

WHEREAS, the County has expressed a willingness to cooperate with the State in achieving the overall objective of safe and efficient movement of traffic on the said highway; and

WHEREAS, the traffic signal system is being constructed pursuant to the Developer Agreement Project S-40-S-19388-2019, A-48-S-19386-2019; dated December 7, 2020, which is incorporated herein by reference and is on file at the New Jersey State Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Agreement is to provide for the participation of the COUNTY and STATE in the cost of maintenance and operation of the said traffic signal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that the County agrees to the terms and conditions of the Agreement and authorizes the County Commissioner Director to sign the Agreement.
