WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners desires to apply for a grant to further the public interest through a grant with the New Jersey Department of Health, Division of Epidemiology, Environmental & Occupational Health, to develop and implement a County Right to Know Program; and

WHEREAS, funding for the project will be in the amount of \$8,786.00 and will be paid in quarterly installments of \$2,196.50 made to the County of Salem Health Department for the fiscal year of July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, this agreement shall further be contingent upon availability and appropriation of sufficient funds for this purpose in the County's temporary and/or permanent budget.
