RESOLUTION APPOINTING A CHAIRPERSON TO DEVELOP AN INDEPENDENT REVIEW PANEL TO REVIEW THE FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE UNIFICATION OF SALEM COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND ALTERNATIVES

WHEREAS, in September 2020, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders were awarded a grant from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs to conduct a Feasibility Study for the Unification of Salem County School Districts and Alternatives; and

WHEREAS, Porzio, Bromberg and Newman Consultants were awarded a professional services contract through the Fair and Open Process to prepare a high-level feasibility study for unification of Salem County School Districts; and

WHEREAS, the study is now complete, and an independent review panel of Salem County stakeholders needs to be established to review the Unification study and make recommendations; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Michael Gorman, President of Salem Community College, has the qualifications needed to develop and lead an independent review panel.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that Dr. Michael Gorman is hereby appointed to develop an independent review panel to review the Feasibility Study for the Unification of Salem County School Districts and Alternatives.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that Dr. Michael Gorman is hereby appointed to serve as chairperson of the independent review panel.
