RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION TO NJ TRANSIT CORPORATION ON BEHALF OF THE SALEM COUNTY OFFICE ON AGING AND DISABILITIES FOR THE 2022 RURAL 5311/NON-URBANIZED TRANSPORTATION GRANT

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners authorize the Salem County Office on Aging and Disabilities to submit an application to NJ Transit Corporation for the 2022 Rural 5311/Non-Urbanized transportation Grant for the total of \$375,690.00; and

WHEREAS, the grant for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the County of Salem, including the provision of the local share of the project costs in the program, which is being funded by the Salem Health and Wellness Foundation with an anticipated 2020 carryover amount of \$41,547.50 and the new funding amount of \$43,000.00 totaling \$84,547.50; and

WHEREAS, the Rural 5311/Non-Urbanized transportation grant will be for the period covering January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022 in the amount of \$291,142.50; and

WHEREAS, it is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1965, that in connection with the filing of an application for assistance under the Federal Transit Act, as amended, the County of Salem gives an assurance that it will comply with Title VI and EEO requirements of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and U.S. Department of Transportation requirements; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem is required to adhere to the requirements as specified in the U.S. Department of Transportation's Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) regulation set forth in 49 C.F.R. Part 23, Subpart D.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

1. The Salem County Board of County Commissioners are authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the Salem County Office on Aging and Disabilities with NJ Transit Corporation for the 2022 Rural 5311/Non-Urbanized transportation grant for the total amount of \$375,690.00.
2. The Salem County Board of County Commissioners hereby authorize the amount of \$84,547.50 be obligated as the local share required under the provisions of the grant application, funded by Salem Health and Wellness Foundation using the anticipated 2020 carryover amount of \$41,547.50 and the new funding amount of \$43,000.00.
3. The Salem County Board of County Commissioners are authorized to execute and file an application with NJ Transit Corporation whom as the Designated Recipient will apply to the U.S. Department of Transportation requesting aid in the financing of administration, capital and/or operating assistance projects pursuant to Section 5311 of the Federal Transit Act, in the amount of \$291,142.50 for the period covering January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022.

4. The Salem County Board of County Commissioners are authorized to execute and file with such applications and assurances or any other document required by the U.S. Department of Transportation effectuating the purposes of Title VI, ADA and EEO requirements of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
5. The Salem County Board of County Commissioners are authorized to set forth and execute affirmative minority business policies pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Part 23, Subpart D.
6. The Salem County Board of County Commissioners are authorized to furnish such additional information as the U.S. Department of Transportation may require in connection with the application.
7. The Salem County Board of County Commissioner Director and County Counsel are authorized to execute grant agreements on behalf of the Salem County Office on Aging and Disabilities for aid in the financing of the administration, capital and/or operating assistance.
