RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH MID-ATLANTIC STATES CAREER AND EDUCATION CENTER FOR THE MUTUAL TERMINATION TWO (2) CONTRACTS FOR THE PROVISION OF CERTAIN TRANSPORTATION SERVICES EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2021 (CURB TO CURB PROGRAM and NON-EMERGENT MEDICAL SHUTTLE PROGRAM)

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2019, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners passed Resolution #2019-429 awarding a contract for Curb to Curb transportation services to Mid-Atlantic States Career and Education Center, said contract commenced on January 1, 2020 and was set to terminate on December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, in addition, Mid-Atlantic States Career and Education Center (MASCEC) was also providing non-emergent medical shuttle services to residents on behalf of the County to Delaware, Dialysis, Camden and Philadelphia appointments, which is based upon a verbal agreement between the parties effective January 1, 2021. Said verbal agreement constituted the same terms and conditions as a contract awarded by the County to MASCEC pursuant to Resolution 2018-94 on February 7, 2018, which terminated on December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the County of Salem and Mid-Atlantic Career and Education Center have now mutually agreed to prematurely terminate both of the afore-referenced contractual arrangements, based upon the parties mutual agreement and understanding and pursuant to terms and conditions as more fully set forth in a Memorandum of Agreement dated August 18, 2021; and

WHEREAS, specifically the parties have agreed that both contracts are to terminate on August 31, 2021 and that date shall be the last date that MASCEC will operate transportation services for either program on behalf of the County of Salem.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Salem County Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes a Memorandum of Agreement terminating the following contracts in effect between the County of Salem and Mid-Atlantic Career and Education Center:

1. Specialized Transportation Services, also known as Curb to Curb Transportation; and

2. Medical Transportation, designed to provide transportation to Delaware, Dialysis, Camden and Philadelphia appointments.
