**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A
SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE APPLICATION FOR
STATE AID TO COUNTIES UNDER THE
NEW JERSEY TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020
COUNTY AID IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Salem County Engineer’s Office made application to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for funds from the TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND; and

WHEREAS, the Board previously granted approval of the aforesaid application by Resolution No. 2020-071, dated February 5, 2020 and, therefore, approves acceptance and execution of this Grant; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation has obligated funds for the “2020 COUNTY AID PROGRAM” in the amount of \$4,905,522.00 in accordance with the notice of “Executed Funding Agreement” letter dated April 7, 2020 for the specific projects listed below:

1. Resurfacing of Walnut Street, County Road #665 from NJ Route #49 to Grieves Parkway, a local road- 0.49 miles in the City of Salem;
2. Resurfacing of Sickler Street, County Road #651 from NJ Route #49 to Beasley Neck Road, County Road #651 – 0.57 miles in Quinton Township;
3. Resurfacing of Alloway-Friesburg Road, County Road #640 from South Greenwich Street, County Road #540 to Camp Edge Road, a local road – 0.72 miles in Alloway Township;
4. Resurfacing of Broad Street, County Road #662 from Salem Street, County Road #611 to South Main Street, County Road #648 – 0.88 miles in the Borough of Elmer;
5. Resurfacing of Alloway-Aldine Road, County Road #611 from Main Street, County Road #581 to NJ Route #77 – 6.39 miles in Alloway Township and Upper Pittsgrove Township;
6. Resurfacing of Perkintown Road, County Road #644 from Straughns Mill Road, County Road #643 to Pennsville-Auburn Road, County Road #551 – 1.37 miles in Oldmans Township;
7. Resurfacing of Georgetown Road, County Road #629 from U.S. Route #130 to Pennsville-Auburn Road, County Road #551 – 1.32 miles in Carneys Point Township;
8. Resurfacing of Marilton Road, County Road #636 from NJ Route #45 to Marilton Recreation Area – 0.7 miles in the Borough of Woodstown and Pilesgrove Township;
9. Resurfacing of Jericho Road, County Road #626 from Harmersville-Pecks Corner Road, County Road #667 to the Cumberland County Line – 3.21 miles in Quinton Township and Lower Alloways Creek Township;
10. Resurfacing of East Line Street, County Road #641 from U.S. Route #130 to North Broad Street, County Road #607 – 0.32 miles in Carneys Point Township and the Borough of Penns Grove;
11. Resurfacing of Elm Street, County Road #602 from U.S. Route #40 to NJ Route #45 – 0.59 miles in the Borough of Woodstown;
12. Resurfacing of Dutch Row Road, County Road #611 from U.S. Route #40 to Centerton Road, County Road #610 – 0.90 miles in Pittsgrove Township;

13. Resurfacing of Centerton Road, County Road #610 from Buck Road, County Road #553 to South Main Street, County Road #648 – 3.00 miles in Pittsgrove Township and the Borough of Elmer;
14. Resurfacing of Grant Street, County Road #657 from NJ Route #45 to the City of Salem/Mannington Township Line – 0.75 miles in the City of Salem;

WHEREAS, the Board Amended the aforementioned original Application for the 2020 COUNTY AID GRANT PROGRAM to include the following location on December 2, 2020 per Resolution #2020-420:

1. Add the following Project to the 2020 County Aid Resurfacing Program due to the County's desire to partner with Lower Alloways Creek Township to fund the improvements: Resurfacing of a portion of Locust Island Road, County Road #658 and a portion of Alloway Creek Neck Road, County Road #658 at the "T" Intersection with Alloway Creek Neck Road, a Township Road – 0.277 miles in Lower Alloways Creek Township; and


WHEREAS, the County, at the recommendation of the County Engineer, would like to Amend the original Application for a second time as follows:

1. Add repairs to damaged Salem County Railroad north of Oldmans Creek Road which involves erosion of the railroad embankment beginning at approximately 850 feet north of Oldmans Creek Road and extending to approximately 1,350 feet north of Oldmans Creek road in Woolwich Township, Gloucester County – a distance of approximately 500 feet; and

WHEREAS, no funding match is required for this Grant; and

WHEREAS, this Grant and Projects are to be referenced as the 2020 COUNTY AID IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salem that we approve the second Amendment to the Application made to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for funding under the NEW JERSEY TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND AUTHORITY ACT for FISCAL YEAR 2020 for transportation projects as described herein.
