**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
ACCEPTING AND EXECUTING A GRANT
FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2021
COUNTY AID IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Salem County Engineer's Office made application to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for funds from the TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND; and

WHEREAS, the Board previously granted approval of the aforesaid application by Resolution No. 2020-421, dated December 2, 2020 and, therefore, approves acceptance and execution of this Grant; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation has obligated funds for the "2021 COUNTY AID PROGRAM" in the amount of \$4,886,128.00 for the specific projects listed below:

ROADWAY PRESERVATION PROJECTS

1. Resurfacing of Porchtown Road, County Road #613 from Centerton Road, County Road #553 to the Salem County/Gloucester County Line – 5.42 miles in Pittsgrove Township;
2. Resurfacing of Chestnut Street, County Road #625 from NJ Route #49 to the Salem City/Elsinboro Township Line – 1.3 miles in the City of Salem;
3. Resurfacing of Penns Grove-Auburn Road, County Road #641 from US Route #130 to Pointers-Auburn Road, County Road #646 - 5.24 miles in Carneys Point Township and Oldmans Township;
4. Resurfacing of Beasley Neck Road, County Road #651 from Sickler Street, County Road #651 to New Bridge Road, County Road #623 – 2.4 miles in Quinton Township and Lower Alloways Creek Township;
5. Resurfacing Tilbury Road, County Road #661 from Grieves Parkway, local road to South Tilbury Road, County Road #627 – 0.7 miles in the City of Salem and Elsinboro Township;
6. Resurfacing Sinnickson Landing Road, County Road #661 from Salem-Fort Elfsborg Road, County Road #625 to Tilbury Road, County Road #627 – 1.82 miles in Elsinboro Township;
7. Resurfacing of South Tilbury Road, County Road #627 from Tilbury Road, County Road #627 to Salem-Fort Elfsborg Road, County Road #625 – 0.87 miles in Elsinboro Township;
8. Resurfacing of North Hook Road, County Road #551 from approximately 175 feet north of Lee Avenue, local road to approximately 1,400 feet north of Lee Avenue, local road – 0.23 miles in Pennsville Township; and
9. Resurfacing of Salem-Fort Elfsborg Road, County Road #624 from Fort Elfsborg Road, County Road #624 to terminus – 0.62 miles in Elsinboro Township.

ROADWAY SAFETY PROJECTS


1. Flashing Beacons, Signage, Striping and other Safety Improvements at Various Locations as recommended by Traffic Studies; and
2. Bridge Guide Rail Improvements at Various Locations as recommended by Bridge Inspection Reports.

WHEREAS, no funding match is required for this Grant; and


WHEREAS, this Grant and Projects are to be referenced as the 2021 COUNTY AID IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

Enclosed is one copy of the executed Agreement approved by the Department of Transportation for the above referenced project in the amount of \$4,886,128.00.

This project will be funded from the New Jersey Transportation Trust Fund Authority Act. Disbursement of funds from the annual allotment will be made on a project-by-project basis pursuant to N.J.A.C. 16:20A-6.2. (100% of the award amount) up to the County's available balance, whichever is less).

The construction Contract must be awarded within 36 months from the agreement date of 5/7/2021. Failure to make an award by the contract deadline or to comply with the requirements of the County Aid Regulations 16:20A and the Terms and Conditions of Grant Agreement will jeopardize the use of State funds on this project. It is further noted that the project must be in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, ADA, requirements for accessibility. 

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION AND EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT FOR STATE AID TO COUNTIES UNDER THE NEW JERSEY TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021

WHEREAS, the NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION has made available \$4,886,128.00 for construction, reconstruction or resurfacing of roads, bridge preservation and roadway safety improvements under the NEW JERSEY TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND AUTHORITY ACT for FISCAL YEAR 2021; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that projects more particularly described in the GRANT AGREEMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 STATE AID TO COUNTIES, 2021 SALEM COUNTY ATP are in need of resurfacing or improving.
