RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF A VEHICLE TO THE SALEM COUNTY VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the County of Salem, Sheriff's Office of Emergency Services/Fire Academy has determined that a 1989 Imperial PEMFAB/Grumman, fire engine, color: red/white, bearing vehicle identification number 1P1F105B3CA089006, is no longer needed for their purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Vocational Technical High School, Law Enforcement and Public Safety (LEPS) program, has expressed an interest in acquiring such a vehicle to utilize for the purposes of firefighter and firefighter recruit training; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 12-21.1 permits the sale of property to the Vocational Technical School District, without compliance with any other law governing disposal of property by Counties or Municipalities, for a consideration, which may be nominal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. The County of Salem transfers the vehicle noted above in return for the payment of One Dollar (\$1.00) to the Salem County Vocational Technical School District for their use in educating students within the LEPS program, as well as the vehicle being used in other SCVTS shops for educational purposes.
