RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF A VEHICLE FROM THE TOWNSHIP OF OLDMANS TO THE SALEM COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES / FIRE ACADEMY (NUNC PRO TUNC)

WHEREAS, the Township of Oldmans (Auburn Fire Company) has determined that a 1996 HME Model TCM 42-65-440, VIN# - 44KFT4284IWZ18339, odometer reading - 4491.4, color - red/white, is no longer needed for their purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Services / Fire Academy has expressed an interest in acquiring such a vehicle to utilize for the purposes of firefighter and firefighter recruit training; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 12-21.1 permits the sale of property to the County without compliance with any other law governing disposal of property by Counties or Municipalities, for a consideration, which may be nominal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. The County accepts the vehicle noted above in return for the payment of One Dollar (\$1.00)
2. The county purchasing agent is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate to sale of said vehicle, including the transfer of the NJ Department of Motor Vehicle title and to make provisions for insurance of said vehicle.



