RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2020-270 AND RESOLUTION 2020-395 TO EXTEND THE FUNDING PERIOD FROM NEW JERSEY TRANSIT CORPORATION FOR CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE THROUGH NEW JERSEY CARES ACT SECTION 5311 NON-URBANIZED TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the County of Salem approved Resolution 2020-270 for the Office on Aging and Disabilities to receive funding from New Jersey Transit Corporation for Coronavirus Response through New Jersey Cares Act Section 5311 Non-Urbanized Transportation in the amount of \$618,957.00 (Six Hundred Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Seven Dollars and Zero Cents) for the funding period from March 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 with no required match; and


WHEREAS, the County of Salem passed Resolution 2020-395 amending Resolution 2020-270 for the Office on Aging and Disabilities to accept funding from New Jersey Transit Corporation for Coronavirus Response through New Jersey Cares Act Section 5311 Non-Urbanized Transportation to increase the allocation funding amount by \$1.00 (One Dollar and Zero Cents) to \$618,958.00 (Six Hundred Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Eight Dollars and Zero Cents) and extend the funding period from March 1, 2020 through July 31, 2021 with no match required; and

WHEREAS, the attached Supplemental Agreement Extension terms state the existing amount will remain at \$618,958.00 (Six Hundred Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Eight Dollars and Zero Cents) and extends the funding period from March 1, 2020 through December 31, 2022 with no required match.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

1. The Salem County Board of County Commissioners passed Resolution 2020-270 for the Office on Aging and Disabilities to accept funding from New Jersey Transit Corporation for Coronavirus Response through New Jersey Cares Act Section 5311 Non-Urbanized Transportation in the amount of \$618,957.00 for funding period March 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020, with no required match.
2. The Salem County Board of County Commissioners passed Resolution 2020-395 to amend Resolution 2020-270 to include the attached Supplemental Agreement which includes the increased funding amount of \$618,958.00 and extends the funding period from March 1, 2020, through July 31, 2021.

3. The Salem County Board of County Commissioners accepts the attached Supplemental Agreement Extension which extends the funding period from March 1, 2020, through December 31, 2022.

This letter will serve as a modification to your FY 2020 Section 5311 CARES Supplemental contract from March 1, 2020- July 31, 2021 to **March 1, 2020 – December 31, 2022**. This modification specifically modifies the following term in your agreement:

Page 2 – 1., Period of Availability of Funds, shall be modified to County of Salem’s FY 2020 Section 5311 CARES Contract through midnight December 31, 2022.

All other conditions of the FY 2020 FTA Section 5311 CARES Supplemental agreement dated November 2, 2020 will remain the same. Please note there is no change to funding in this agreement.
