**RESOLUTION BY THE SALEM COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
ACCEPTING ADDITIONAL RERP 966 FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 FROM
THE NJ DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY FOR THE COUNTY OF
SALEM.**

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners recognizes the need to assist the Salem County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Management and the Emergency First Responders involved with the Radiological emergency response program, in a continuing endeavor to make Salem County a safe place; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Law & Public Safety, Office of Emergency Management approved an application by Salem County for funding, provided through the NJ Radiological 966 Funding Program and for confidentiality reasons, remain on file with the Sheriff's Office of Emergency Management: and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 2021-200 for the original funds, in the amount of \$250,124.87. The Board recognizes that additional funding for the FY21 RERP 966 Funding Program, in the amount of \$4,500.00, is necessary to cover the five Salem County Municipalities Emergency Operating Centers (EOC) phone bills, which normally would be paid directly to the municipalities and bringing the total funds for the FY21 RERP 966 Funding Program to \$254,624.87.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

1. The EOC phone bills are normally paid directly to the municipalities, but this year funds will pass through the County and be disbursed to the municipalities with this additional funding.
2. The Administrator and the project contact person from the Sheriff's Office of Emergency Management, as well as any other necessary parties, are hereby authorized and directed to execute all funding requirements and documentation filings as directed by the New Jersey State Police Emergency Management.
3. One fully executed copy of the resolution shall be provided to the Sheriff's Office of Emergency Management forthwith.
