RESOLUTION RESTRICTING PARKING ALONG VETERANS WAY, COUNTY ROAD #681 IN OLDMANS TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF SALEM

WHEREAS, the Township of Oldmans requested a parking restriction along both sides of Veterans Way, County Road #681; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Oldmans requested the "NO PARKING" designation to prohibit on street parking within the "Gateway Industrial Complex"; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has investigated Veterans Way, County Road #681 and recommends the following parking restrictions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1. PARKING be and is hereby restricted along both sides of Veterans Way, County Road #681 from intersection of Gateway Boulevard, County Road #680 running in a southerly direction for 2,100 feet to the end of the road.
2. The Salem County Road Supervisor be and is hereby authorized to erect the proper signage as required by law with installation conforming to the standards set forth in the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices".
3. A duly certified copy of this Resolution will be forwarded to the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Transportation along with law enforcement.
