WHEREAS, the County has determined that the project, more particularly described in the GRANT APPLICATION and AGREEMENT for FISCAL YEAR 2022 LOCAL FREIGHT IMPACT FUND, as RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS TO ACTON STATION ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #653 from NJ Route #49 to NJ Route #45, in QUINTON AND MANNINGTON TOWNSHIPS FOR THE COUNTY OF SALEM.
